

Preparing Research Articles for Publication in the Sri Lanka Journal of Agrarian Studies

The *Journal of Agrarian Studies* Scientific Journal, published by the Hector Kobbekaduwa Agrarian Research and Training Institute, is a semi-annual publication subjected to double-blind review. It features scholarly articles, recent research findings, reviews, and book reviews related to agrarian and rural development in Sri Lanka and other regional countries.

The aim of this scientific journal is to provide a platform for scientists and researchers to share and discuss knowledge on issues and perspectives related to agriculture and rural development. Accordingly, it accepts research articles covering a wide range of multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary themes, including: agricultural and production economics, extension services and communication, agricultural marketing, food and nutrition security, price policy, post-harvest losses, disaster risk reduction and adaptation to climate change, environmental resource management, public participation and social mobilization, community and rural development, land use and agrarian relations, resettlement, poverty, income disparities and non-farm employment, rural credit and microfinance, labour and migration, among others.

Special guidelines for preparing research articles are provided below.

1. Articles submitted for publication in the *Journal of Agrarian Studies* Scientific Journal must not have been previously published in any other publication, nor should they be under consideration by any other publisher. Furthermore, articles submitted for publication in this journal must not be published elsewhere, in this format or in another language, without the permission of the Editorial Board. When submitting articles, both a soft copy and a PDF version must be provided.
2. **Manuscript Format**
 - Title Page: Must include the name(s) of the author(s) and the email address of the corresponding author.
 - Abstract: Should not exceed 250 words; font size 11", italic.
 - Keywords: Maximum of 5.
 - Introduction (including the research problem and objectives)
 - Methodology
 - Results and Discussion
 - Conclusions
 - Acknowledgements (optional)
 - References (in APA style).
 - Font: Calibri, size 11".
 - Margins: Left – 1.5", Right – 1"
 - Line spacing – 1.15
 - Justify

- Paper size – B5
 - Signs and Symbols for units- SI
3. The text of the manuscript should be between 4,500 to 8,000 words. Research papers that fail to comply with the guidelines will be returned to the authors without being considered for reviewing.
 4. When referring to institutions, organizations, etc., their full name should be stated first, and the English name should also be provided where necessary.
 5. The full responsibility, decision-making authority, and publication rights for the articles rest with the Hector Kobbekaduwa Agrarian Research and Training Institute.
 6. Each author will receive a free copy of the journal issue in which their article is published. Unless a special request is made by the author, the submitted manuscript will not be returned after publication.
